**Puddle Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies. No cross entry with classes 20-25, including riders.

**Novice Jumper:** Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing as Jumpers at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/19. No cross entry with classes 20-25.

**Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper**: Open to horses and ponies ridden by children and adult amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing as Jumpers 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/19. No cross entry with classes 20-25. **Jr/AA Jumper Equitation**: Open to juniors & adult amateurs.

## **Rules and Regulations**

**OFFICE/SCHOOLING FEE.** A \$10.00 Office Fee will be charged per horse/pony entered.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS. Every class offered herein, covered by the rules and regulations of the current VHSA Rule Books will be conducted and judged accordingly. The Judges' decisions are always final.

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

Jumper and Hunter: \$15.00 per class.. Hunter Division: \$45.00 per Division.

Warm Up fee: \$15.00 per horse.

Returned checks: \$50.00.

**SCHOOLING.** Will be permitted only in designated schooling areas. Schooling available from 7:30-8:45 a.m. prior to the show. All Juniors must have an adult oversee schooling.

# **Schooling Fee on Friday: \$25.00 per horse.**

**COGGINS TEST-** All exhibitors must present a Negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State law.

**EXHIBITOR-** All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets at all times while mounted on the show grounds with harness secured. Proper attire and equipment expected; jackets may be excused at Judges discretion.

**AWARDS:** Six ribbons per class. Champion and Reserve Champion trophies and ribbons in all divisions.

**RESPONSIBILITIES-** Gray Horse Farm and their officials and employees, will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. Any equine activity, sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. This complies with the Virginia Equine Liability Act (3.2-6200 thru 3.2-6203 as amended of the Code of Virginia), which is hereby incorporated by reference. The show reserves to itself the right to decline to accept any entry and return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable for compensation; to change location, combine, cancel, or limit any classes; or change any officials.

## DOGS- All Dogs must be on a leash while on the show grounds.

COVID-19- All exhibitors, owners, trainers, riders, other employees, officials, spectators must comply with all regulations, procedures, and actions required by the show, ground owners, town, state, and may be amended at any time.

#### **Division Specifications**

**Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation.** Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/19. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

**Working Hunter.** Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. Jumps 2'9", 3'. May be combined with Schooling Hunter, Green Hunter,

**Schooling Hunter.** Open to horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. To jump, 2'6". May be combined with Working Hunter, Green Hunter.

**Green Pony Hunter.** Open to ponies (14.2 hands and under) in their first year of showing over fences, including pleasure and equitation classes over fences at or above 2' for Small Ponies, 2'3" for Medium Ponies and 2'6" for Large Ponies as of 12/1/19, ridden by juniors. The Green Pony division may be combined with the Green Hunter division or the Pony Hunter division.

**Green Hunter.** Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher including pleasure and equitation classes as of 12/1/19.

All Hunter Classes to be judged on performance and soundness, with emphasis on manners and suitability in pony, children's and adult amateur. Over fences classes not to jog.

All Equitation Classes to be judged on hands, seat guidance and control.

All Riders ages of 12/1/19.

Jr/AA Jumper Equitation. Open to Junior riders and Adult Amateurs. To be shown over at least 10 fences with at least one combination, four oxers and a minimum of two additional jumper style tests which may include a Liverpool, narrow fence, rollback turn, fence at the end of the ring, option fence. To be offered at two heights, 2'6"and 3', with spreads not to exceed height, with one set of awards. Judge may ask some or all riders to return on the flat, the number of riders to return at the judge's discretion. Flat work may include shortening and lengthening of stride at all gaits and work without irons, and such other tests as the judge deems appropriate. Riders requested to wear coats and boots. Paddock boots with jodphurs or matching half chaps allowed. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control and optimum time. Numerical scoring. Course must be measured and the Time Allowed and Optimum Times posted. Should a rider exceed the Time Allowed and gain Time Faults, those faults will reduce the numerical score.

**Leadline.** Riders 7 years and under. Rider not eligible for any other classes where they would trot. Rider to be led at the walk. Pony to be led at all times. Classes to be judged on rider's equitation, and pony's suitability and manners as a leadline mount, as specified.

**Short Stirrup Equitation.** Riders 12 years and under. May not enter any classes with fences over 18". May trot or canter over fences. May not cross enter in any other equitation class except Equitation on the Flat, and any class with jumps over 18".

**Student Equitation.** Riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing at 2' or higher. Jumps not to exceed 2'. May trot or canter over fences and simple changes allowed.

**Junior, Pony, Adult Amateur Equitation.** Junior riders and Adult Amateur riders. Small ponies to jump 2', Medium ponies to jump 2'3", Large Ponies to jump 2'6" and Horses to jump 2'6" or 3' over a course of at least 6 fences. Option: At least ½ to return to hack. In Pony Equitation only junior riders.

**Equitation on the Flat.** Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs, to show at the walk, trot and canter. Judges may do additional tests. To be split Adult Amateurs, Juniors 15-17 and juniors 14 and under if entries warrant.

**Pleasure Horse.** Open to horses ridden by juniors and adults. Judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners and suitability. To be split Adult and Junior Pleasure if entries warrant.

Pony Pleasure. Open to Ponies ridden by juniors. Judged same as Horse Pleasure.

**Pony Hunter**. Open to Small Ponies not over 12.2 hands to jump 2', Medium Ponies over 12.2 but not over 13.2 hands to jump 2'3" and Large Ponies over 13.2 but not over 14.2 hands to jump 2'6". Junior riders. If 4 or more Large Ponies and 4 or more Small/Medium Ponies to be split.

**Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter.** Open to horses over 14.2 hands ridden by juniors and horses or ponies not shown in any pony division, ridden by Adult Amateurs to jump 2'6" or 3'. Children's and Adult Amateur to be split if entries warrant.

Low Hunter. Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. To jump 2' or 2'3".
